

Herefordshire Housing and Economic Land Availability Assessment (HELAA) 2020- Call for Sites form

Herefordshire Council is issuing a county-wide call for sites. Those who wish to promote land for development should complete the form below to the best of their knowledge. If promoting a site that has not before been included in a SHLAA, or the boundaries of it have changed since its last publication, then promoters should also include an accurate location plan of the site with the boundaries clearly marked in red.

Additionally, differently to previous exercises, we are seeking to assess some sites also on their potential for employment-based development where appropriate. Hence this particular exercise is entitled Housing and Economic Land Availability Assessment (HELAA). If you would like or are open to the possibility of your site being assessed for employment use potential, then please indicate on the relevant section of the form.

The call for sites opens for submissions on Monday 3rd August 2020, and closes at midnight on Monday 14th September 2020. Sites are sought that are within or close to an existing settlement, and of an area of at least 0.25 hectares.

Given the current situation regarding Covid-19, many of our officers are working remotely, so we would strongly encourage electronic submissions if at all possible please. However, if this is not possible, then please post to the below address.
